Are you a UK taxpayer? If so, you can use Gift Aid to make your donations go further. If you Gift Aid your donation, RNIB will receive an additional 25p on every pound you give. It's simple – just tick the "Gift Aid" box and ensure you include your full name, home address and postcode.

By ticking the box you are confirming that you have paid, or will pay, an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for the current tax year (6 April of one year to 5 April the next) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities, and Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs), that you donate to will reclaim on your gifts for the current tax year. Council Tax and VAT do not qualify towards Gift Aid. RNIB will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that has been given.
